External Interventions in NT

- Coaching church leaders (often by letter, esp. Timothy)
- Evaluating & making recommendations about leadership
- Responding to issues raised or that had come to Paul's attention
 - Divisions in the church, conflict, lawsuits
 - Immorality
 - Marriage & singleness
 - Exercising spiritual gifts appropriately
 - Worship
 - False teachers, doctrinal error
 - Church discipline
 - Giving to the poor

Evaluating Churches

NB: Care with this – who does the evaluating in a consultancy?

- God is an evaluator (Jesus evaluates churches Rev 2-3)
- Assessment is often delegated by God to leaders
- Every person should assess themselves spiritually (care selfdeception: invited personal accountability/structural accountability)
- NT letters evaluate churches & individuals

Basis: 5 purposes of a church, a church's specific vision, & Bible

A Multi-faceted Christian Ministry

Seeks to minister to churches & individuals
Shares many characteristics of other Christian ministries in encouraging towards growth & health

- Ministry of comfort & consolation
- Exhortation
- Equipping/build capacity
- Reconciliation
- Evangelism, in facilitating a greater missional focus
