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| Topic | The character of God: His love. | The character of God: His goodness. | The character of God: His desire for relationship with humankind. | The character of God: His intended purpose for our lives. | The work of Jesus Christ through the cross and the family of God. |
| Aim and Unit Description. | For students to explore the key Biblical concept of God's love for humankind, this love being revealed through Jesus Christ's death on the cross. This Love is experienced as life-transforming. | For students to explore the key Biblical concept of God's trustworthiness, as revealed in the mission of Christ to seek and to save those who are lost. | For students to explore both the knowledge of God as well as what it means to know God. That through Jesus Christ Christians enter a personal relationship with our heavenly Father. | For students to explore the Christian teaching that God has provided a way through which evil and sin can be overcome. That through Jesus Christ Christians are forgiven, promised eternal life and established within a community of other believers. | For students to explore the key Biblical concept that God is a loving and accepting Father, whose unconditional love can bring significant and lasting character change to an individual and/or community. |
| Outcomes | For students to become familiar with John 3:16-17. For each student to know that they are loved by God. | For students to see the mission of Jesus Christ through the Bible story of the lost sheep. For students to see the faithfulness of God. | For students to see that knowing God is as important as knowledge of God. Students will see that this relationship with God impacts all of life. | Assesses and evaluates a Biblical worldview on the power of Jesus Christ to bring transformation to human life, and what this means for the life of a contemporary believer. | For Students to have explored the Fatherly characteristics of God. For students to see the positive change faith brings into a person's life. |
