

Facilitators Guide – Fostering Friendship Workshop

This workshop was created by Louise Bartlett Team Leader for Kids and Family Ministries for the Baptist Association with input from Sheridan Voysey from Friendship Lab. The workshop includes a video, and opportunities for discussion.

Setting Up Your Space

• You will need space to watch and discuss the video in small groups. Discussion **activities** can be done in several small groups around the room.

WORKSHOP OUTLINE (50 MINUTES)

Your intro: (4 mins)

- Let participants know this is a workshop about helping children and young people develop friendships that are healthy and encourage faith
- Everyone will receive a link to the video to watch it again and share with their team.
- Get some interaction from the group around these two questions
 - o Who has had the longest friendship?
 - o Who has made a new friend recently? How did you meet? What started the friendship?

Video Intro (9 mins)

[0:00-9:30] Introduction to friendship including research

Pause & Chat (max 2mins)

Ask participants to chat in small groups of 2-3 about what caught their attention so far

Video (5 mins)

• [9:30-14:18] Making Friendships | Friends or acquaintances?

Encouraging Friendships – shared experiences and program content

Personal Reflection (1 min)

No need to stop the video - there is a 1 minute counter on screen. This is a time for personal reflection about the opportunities in each person's own ministry context to better facilitate friendship making.

Video (10 mins)

[15:20-25:20] Maintaining Friendships | Unhealthy friendship

Handling conflict in friendship PeaceWise framework Friendly Culture Intergenerational friendships

Pause & Chat (10 mins)

- If possible, form groups with people who work with the same age-group or in a similar ministry space
 - Firstly, take a moment to think about your ministry context. How friendly is it what do you think needs strengthening the most: making friendships or maintaining friendships?
 - Share anything you have tried or would like to try within the ministry program to help strengthen friendship
 - When it comes to conflict in friendship what role can we as ministry leaders play?
 - What are the ways your church is developing intergenerational friendships?
 - What are the next steps for your team to dial up the friendship building culture at your church?
- Provide time to discuss and wrap up the session. (5 mins)

Note:

For SRE teachers this workshop has less specific application but is still helpful learning about children and teens. For any SRE teachers attending this workshop help them to focus on the ways that the curriculum supports friendship building in the school space. In addition, help them to think about their own local church setting and what they observe about friendship.
